

The collection boasts over 500 whiskies from Speyside, Islay, Campbeltown, the Highlands and the Lowlands.

Scotch's collection is overseen by three highly trained Whisky Ambassadors who are on hand to offer guests advice when selecting a dram. The Whisky Ambassadors wear contemporary highland attire by Kinloch Anderson, kilt makers to Her Majesty The Queen, in cheviot, game keeper and gold tweeds mixed with gold satin trims and whisky coloured accents.


Dinner in TING Restaurant at the Chef's table hosted by Shangri-La Hotel, At The Shard


